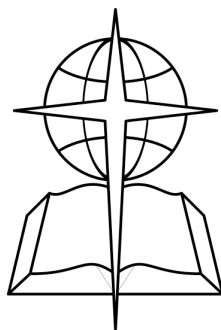
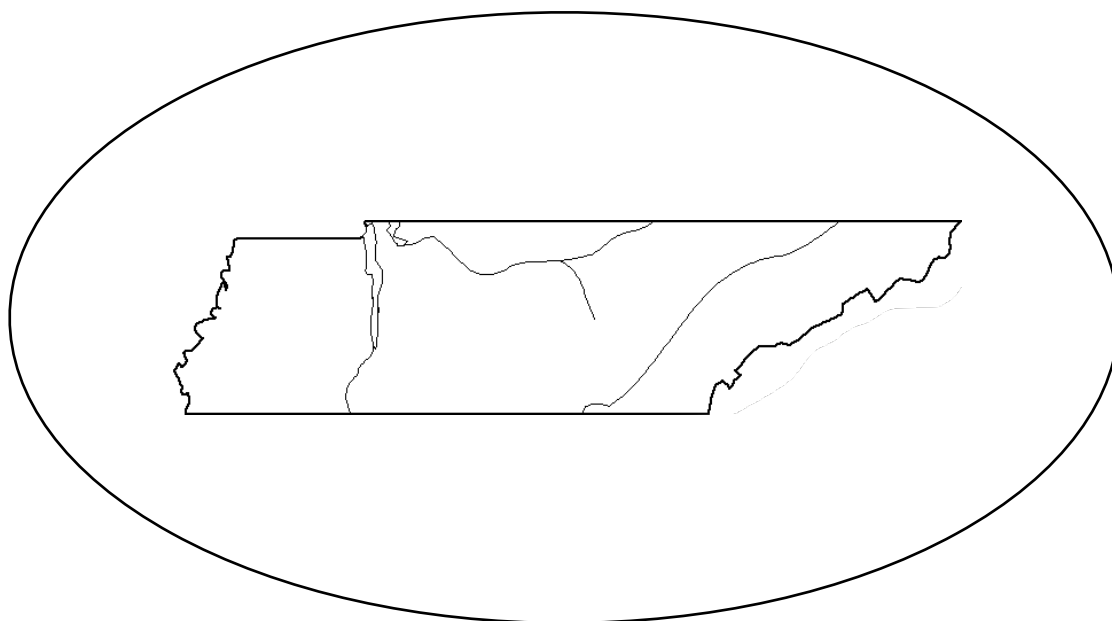

# **CONSTITUTION**

## **Preamble**

WHEREAS, having been organized in 1849, we the Churches of the Judson Association of Baptists, being convinced that an association of churches can more effectively perpetuate the cause of Christ, do adopt the following Articles as written bond of fellowship, cooperative function, and administrative purpose.

## **Article I - Name**

This Association shall be called the Judson Baptist Association.

## **Article II - Mission**

The mission of this Association shall be to further the cause of Christ by enabling the churches in worship, ministry, evangelism, fellowship, and discipleship; and to provide staff leadership and volunteer services in order to fulfill this mission...

## **Article III - Membership**

A member church shall be a Baptist church, cooperating with the Judson Baptist Association, the Tennessee Baptist Convention, and the Southern Baptist Convention. Member churches agree with the general intent of The Baptist Faith and Message.

A church may become a member of the Association by petitioning the Association in writing at any time, but at least ninety (90) days prior to the annual meeting. Petitioning churches shall be under the watch care of the Association until voted upon at the next annual meeting.

A church may voluntarily withdraw from the Association at any time by notifying the Association in writing. However, such withdrawal shall not become final until voted upon by either the Executive Board or Messengers at the Annual Meeting.

## **Article IV - Authority**

The Association shall abstain from internal problems of a participating church except upon request of the involved congregation, and shall exercise no ecclesiastical authority over any church.

## **Article V - Annual Meeting**

The Association shall meet annually in October, the time, date, and place to be set by the messengers in the annual meeting.

## **Article VI - Parliamentary Procedure**

Robert's Rules of Order (latest revised edition) shall be recognized as the authority in parliamentary procedures.

## **Article VII - Messengers**

The voting body at the Annual Meeting of the Association shall be comprised of messengers duly chosen by the churches.

Every Church in this Association shall be entitled to a minimum of three (3) messengers. A church is entitled to an additional messenger for every twenty-five (25) members, or fraction thereof, exceeding fifty (50) members. No church shall be entitled to more than ten (10) messengers.

## **Article VIII - Officers**

### **Section A:**

1. The officers of this Association shall be a Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, Trustees, and Directors of Associational Departments, all of whom shall be elected annually, except as otherwise specified, and shall continue in office until a successor is elected.

2. Annually elected Officers shall be recognized and take office just prior to adjournment of the business session of the Annual Meeting.

3. The Nominating Committee shall nominate officers at the Annual Meeting, and an opportunity for nominations from the floor shall be given.

4. Interim Officers may be appointed as deemed necessary by the Executive Board.

5. All Officers are expected to attend the Annual Meeting, the quarterly Officers Meetings, and the Executive Board Meetings unless providentially hindered.

### **Section B:**

#### **1. Trustees**

The Association shall have three (3) trustees, each serving for three (3) years on a rotation basis, with one (1) new member being elected each year. The duty of the trustees shall be to hold in trust all properties of the Judson Baptist Association, and to transact all legal matters pertaining thereto, subject to the direction of the Association.

#### **2. Moderator**

##### **The Duties Of The Moderator Are:**

- a. To preside over the Annual Meeting, called meetings, and the Executive Board Meetings;
- b. To encourage fellowship and mutual care among the churches of the Association;
- c. To appoint members of special committees as the need may arise, and as by the Association;
- d. To serve as an ex-officio member of all committees.

#### **3. Vice-Moderator**

##### **The Duties Of The Vice-Moderator Are:**

- a. To serve as parliamentarian at the Annual Meeting of the Association, called meetings, and Executive Board Meetings;

- b. To preside over the Annual Meeting, called meetings, and the Executive Board Meetings in the absence of the Moderator;
- c. To become Moderator in the event the Moderator should become unable to serve;
- d. To serve as Alternate Treasurer in the event the Treasurer is absent or unable to fulfill his or her duties for a period of thirty (30) days or more.

#### **4. Clerk**

##### **The Duties Of The Clerk Are:**

- a. To serve as recorder for the Annual Meeting of the Association and the Executive Board Meetings;
- b. To prepare and publish the Minutes of the Annual Meeting and the Executive Board Meetings.

#### **5. Treasurer**

##### **The Duties of the Treasurer Are:**

- a. To submit a financial report at the Annual Meeting and the Executive Board Meetings;
- b. To approve records of all money received and disbursed;
- c. To account for and disburse the Associational funds. The Associational Treasury shall not be used by anyone other than the Treasurer;
- d. To be chairperson of the Budget Committee.

#### **6. Sunday School Director**

It shall be the duty of the Sunday School Director to offer encouragement and assistance in establishing and/or promoting the Sunday School of all churches the Association.

#### **7. Discipleship Training Director**

It shall be the duty of the Discipleship Training Director to encourage, promote, or assist in establishing a Discipleship Training program in all churches in the Association.

#### **8. Music Director**

##### **The Duties of the Music Director Are:**

- a. To encourage and/or assist with the music program of all churches in the Association;
- b. To plan, attend, and participate in all Associational Singings.

#### **9. Brotherhood Director**

It shall be the duty of the Brotherhood Director to offer encouragement in establishing and promoting the Brotherhood organization in all churches of the Association.

#### **10. WMU Director**

##### **The Duties of the WMU Director Are:**

- a. To offer encouragement and assistance in establishing or promoting the WMU Organization in all churches of the Association;
- b. To promote and encourage missions and giving to mission offerings;
- c. To attend state and regional WMU functions as often as is practical and feasible;
- d. To serve on the Missions Committee.

#### **11. Youth Director**

**The Duties of the Youth Director Are:**

- a. To assist and encourage all churches of the Association in developing a continuing program of youth training and active participation in evangelism, soul winning, and church leadership;
- b. To serve on the Evangelism Committee.

**12. Evangelism Director**

**The Duties of the Evangelism Director Are:**

- a. To lead the Association in formulating plans for the annual Associational Evangelism Conference and Associational Revival;
- b. To lead the Association to address the priority of evangelism;
- c. To develop programs and functions to involve the Associational evangelistic activity and training;
- d. To serve as chairperson of the Evangelism Committee.

**13. Stewardship Director**

**The Duties of the Stewardship Director Are:**

- a. To encourage and assist all churches in the Association in developing an ongoing stewardship program;
- b. To plan and direct stewardship commitments to the Associational Mission;
- c. To serve as a member of the Budget Committee.

**14. VBS Director**

**The Duties of the VBS Director Are:**

- a. To assist and challenge churches to start, improve and enlarge all areas of VBS through planning, training, administration, consultation, program interpretation, and cooperative projects;
- b. To serve as a member of the Evangelism Committee.

**15. Media-Library Director**

It shall be the duty of the Media-Library Director to maintain historical records of the Association.

**Article IX - Annual Report**

It shall be the responsibility of each church to complete the Annual Church Profile (ACP) provided by the Associational Clerk. All ACPs are due and should be returned to the Clerk by the September First of each year, and must in any event be returned not later than the first day of the Annual Meeting.

**Article X - Executive Board**

The Executive Board of the Association shall consist of all Officers of the Association, the Chairperson of all standing committees, one (1) elected representative from each church, and all church pastors in the Association.

The Executive Board shall meet quarterly. Additionally, the Moderator may call the Executive Board into session at any time upon notice to all Board Members, stating the purpose of the meeting.

Executive Board shall have the authority to transact any necessary Association business arising between sessions, and shall make an annual report to the Association.

The Associational Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer shall be the Officers of the Executive Board. The Moderator or Vice-Moderator shall preside during all Board meetings, and the Clerk shall keep a written record of all proceedings.

### **Article XI - Discipline**

Disciplinary action may be taken by the Association for the following reasons:

1. Neglect of a church to send messengers to the Annual Meeting for two (2) consecutive years;
2. Neglect of a church to submit the Annual Church Profile for two (2) consecutive years;
3. Neglect of a church to financially support the Association for two (2) consecutive years;
4. A gross doctrinal error, as determined by the Association;
5. The Moderator, the Director of Missions, and/or a committee appointed for that purpose should seek reconciliation with the church.

### **Article XII - Amendments**

Any proposal for amending the Constitution must be presented in writing to the Association during the business session of the annual meeting. A period of one year must be given for publication before consideration by the Association and a two-thirds (2/3) vote of messengers present shall be necessary to make such changes.

### **Article XIII-Staff**

#### **Director of Missions**

The Director of Missions shall give general supervision and direction to the total program of the Judson Baptist Association, for the purpose of achieving the objectives as stated in Article II. He shall be called and employed for an indefinite period of time by vote of the Executive Board and/or the Messengers of the Annual Meeting, upon recommendation of the Personnel Search Committee. A detailed job description for the Director of Missions is attached. (Job description not made available to Clerk)

### **Article XIV - Committees**

The following committees, including chairpersons, shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee at the Annual Meeting, and an opportunity for nominations from the floor shall be given. Each committee member shall serve one year beginning at the conclusion of the Annual Meeting.

#### **1. Annual Meeting Committee**

This committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, and have the following responsibilities:

- a. To propose an order of business for the Annual Meeting;
- b. To propose place, dates and speakers for the Annual Meeting at least two years in advance;
- c. To publicize the complete order of business for the Annual Meetings to the churches in the Association at least thirty (30) days in advance;
- d. In cooperation with the Moderator and other program personnel, to arrange for all facilities needed for the Annual Meetings;
- e. To receive invitations from churches and suggestions for program emphasis and personnel for future sessions.



## **2. Budget Committee**

This committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, and shall have the following responsibilities:

- a. To work with the Treasurer, who shall serve as chairperson, in developing and recommending an overall financial development plan;
- b. To work with the Treasurer in developing and recommending an Associational budget based on the Constitutional Objectives stated in Article II;
- c. To make recommendations concerning proposed expenditures not included in the budget;
- d. To review expenditures periodically and recommend budget adjustments if needed.

## **3. Evangelism Committee**

The committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, and shall have the following responsibilities:

- a. To promote the cause of Christ by encouraging all churches to be evangelistic in outreach and in ministering to the lost.
- b. To plan and conduct evangelistic rallies, revivals, and conferences annually.

## **4. Missions Committee**

This committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, and shall have the following responsibilities:

- a. To lead the Association to address the priority of missions in the United States and around the world;
- b. To assist the Director of Missions in the mission work of the Association.

## **5. Nominating Committee**

This committee shall consist of at least four (4) members, and shall have the following responsibilities:

- a. To select, interview, enlist, and recommend Associational officers, standing committee members, and chairpersons;
- b. To present workers to the Association at the Annual Meeting for election;
- c. To assist Associational program leaders in discovering and enlisting qualified persons to fill positions in their respective organizations;
- d. To make recommendations for filling vacancies in positions that may occur during the year.

**Judson Baptist Association 164<sup>th</sup> Annual Session**  
**October 19, 2013**  
**Minutes**

The Judson Baptist Association annual Meeting was held on October 19, 2013 at the Maple Grove Baptist Church in Dickson, TN.

Bro Cecil Gilliland, pastor of Maple Grove Baptist Church opened the meeting with prayer and then turned the meeting over to Vice-Moderator Bro Jerry Duke, to call the meeting to order and to conduct the proceedings.

Bro Jerry Harrison lead the congregation in a hymn “Jesus Is Coming Soon”, accompanist on the piano was Sis Marian Pendergrass.

Sis Kim Cunningham, clerk, called the roll, 11 churches were represented; 45 messengers signed in, this also included First Baptist Church of Bon Aqua, approximately 54 in attendance.

Bro William Gray brought a petition before the churches that the First Baptist Church of Bon Aqua, would like to become a member of the Judson Association. Motion was made to accept this petition by Bro Cecil Gilliland and seconded by Bro Cletus Tidwell, motion carried.

Bro William welcomed First Baptist Church of Bon Aqua as a member of the Association, and also mentioned that Bro Tommy Clifton had helped him put the sign up at the Judson Building; then mentioned that we should turn to page 3 of our Book of Reports for the DOM’s annual report. Bro Gray introduced Bro Joe Shannon to give a report on the mission trip to Ecuador; the words that really stuck out in my mind was “instead of asking the person to come to church was to ask the person to come to Jesus”. Bro Joe also spoke of an 88-year-old lady who changed from a Catholic to a Christian. Bro Joe Shannon will be leading a team in the month of November. It was mentioned there maybe 4 mission trips next year. Bro Nathan Davis went to Montana on a trip this year.

Devotion was given by Bro Howard Coles, his message was found in the book of Psalms 1:1-3 and Isaiah 10:31. He spoke on how to “Learn to Enjoy the River of Life”, emphasis was on the clues found in Verse 3; enjoying where you are, firmly affixed; bring forth your fruit; slow down, learn to walk, enjoy what God has given you.

A tribute to those of our Brothers and Sisters who have gone home to be with the Lord was presented by Bro Wilson Spencer with a video of either the person’s name or a picture that was available, with background music and singing by Sis Debbie Fowlkes of the Gospel Echoes.

Sis Lucille McFarlin, treasurer for the Association, presented a report on the Proposed Monthly Budget for 2013-2014, she emphasized on the Judson Link-Up, found on page 11 of the Book of Reports. Motion was made to accept the report by Sis Lucille McFarlin and seconded by Sis Debbie Gilliland, motion carried.

Bro Nathan Davis, VBS Director of the Association gave us a verbal VBS report of 2013 on the “Colossal Coaster World”; you will also find more pertinent information on page 7 of the Book of Reports. A video presentation of the upcoming year 2014 “AgencyD3”, Discover, Decide, Defend, 1 Peter 3:15 was also given. Everyone was excited about this new adventure. He also mentioned that he would try and put together a meeting for all VBS Directors around the end of November to get an early start on the new VBS year.

Sis Mary Donegan presented the Annual Meeting Committee Report for the next two years. You will find this on page 8 of the Book of Reports.

Treasurer Sis Lucille McFarlin gave the Treasurers report, found on page 10 of the Book of Reports. Motion made to accept by Bro Howard Coles and seconded by Bro Nathan Davis, motion carried.

Nominating Report given by Sis Kim Cunningham found on page 9 of the Book of Reports, motion made to accept by Bro Cecil Gilliland and second by Bro Nathan Davis, motion carried.

There was no old business to be discussed.

New Business was as follows:

- A. Bro William Gray brought to the floor that the 164<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Annual Judson Baptist Association to be dedicated in memory of Sis Edna Tidwell, motion made to accept by Sis Mary Donegan, seconded by Sis Sherry Pendergrass, motion carried.
- B. Motion made by Sis Joyce Davidson to move \$1,000 from the Disaster Relief Fund into the Mission Trip Fund, fund set up to help the ones going on mission trips; motion second by Bro Harry Neal, motion carried.
- C. Motion made by Sis Joyce Davidson that the Association Churches be responsible to clean the Judson Association Building once a month, seconded by Sis Niki Spencer. Bro Jerry Duke will be responsible for setting up the monthly rotation for cleaning of the building.

A love offering for the WMU Endowment fund was taken up in Honor of Sis Mary Donegan.

TBC Representative, Dr Archer Thorpe showed a video with Randy C. Davis giving us a welcome and spoke about the work our DOM and Pastors were doing; He also spoke on the Golden Offering and the new disaster relief building located in Mt Juliet. Dr Thorpe spoke about the Summit Meeting that will be held in Chattanooga. This meeting will be so very important; talked about that 50% of the people in Tennessee is lost, in the year of 1950, 34,550 were baptized in Tennessee, probably in the year of 2013, baptized 23,000. He also spoke about the "1-5-1, Harvest Evangelism Discipleship Plants", on Reaching, Baptizing and to Discipline of lost persons.

Bro Jerry Winfield, from the Tennessee Baptist Children's' Home, referenced Psalms 27:10. The Children's' Home has 200 children, 8 going to college and 4 confessions of faith. The Children's' Home has also been in contact with DCHS, about the Foster Care Initiative, Caring Community Churches Ministry, and looking for foster homes, and he also wanted to thanks us for all of our support thru the Cooperative Programs and extended an invitation to tour the Children's' Home.

Bro William Gray addressed that the Judson Building was being used for an R.G. Lee Center for college credits, several of our Pastors have been able to take advantage of this, most courses are only \$75 plus cost of books.

Bro William Gray and Bro Joe Shannon filled in for Bro Neal Westerman. There will be a Joint M-Night on October 21<sup>st</sup> at McEwen FBC at 7pm. Bro Joe presented the Link-up report found on pages 16-19, he also read the first paragraph of the Link Up Covenant between the Judson Baptist, Stewart Co. Baptist and Truett Baptist Associations on page 16. He also mentioned that

we also have Link UP with 2 other states. Motion made to accept the report by Bro Joe Shannon and second by Bro Harry Neal, motion carried.

Bro Jerry Harrison led congregational hymn “Power In The Blood”, and accompanist on the piano was Sis Marian Pendergrass.

Bro Nathan Wilkerson our speaker for this special occasion spoke on Genesis 4:25-26, with special emphasis on 26c “then began men to call upon the name of the LORD”. He referenced different scriptures, 2 Samuel 22:7, Matthew 21:12-13, Acts 2:42, 10:31, Romans 12:12, 1 Thessalonians 5:7, Matthew 17, Jeremiah 33:3, James 5:16, Hebrew 11:1. Jeremiah 33:3 “Gods phone number. Challenge of today: “We have not because we ask not”; an invitation was also given by Bro Nathan.

Bro Jerry Harrison led the invitational hymn “At The Cross”, and accompanist on the piano was Sis Marian Pendergrass.

Bro Cecil Gilliland wanted to recognize the veterans with some pins after the meeting. He also mentioned about the use of a private retreat at Pigeon Forge, if interest needed to see him after the meeting.

Vice-Moderator Bro Jerry Duke led the dismissal prayer, blessing for the noon meal and benediction.

Meeting ended at 11:05 with a fellowship meal to follow.

Tim Bearden, Senior Manager, provided incredible oversight during the most difficult days of his life. Thank you, Tim.
- 3) The first three years of my tenure as Executive Director have been spent on sharpening our focus for the future. With the declines all across the Southern Baptist Convention, we must think again how we are doing Great Commission work in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. We cannot continue to do “business as usual.” The report of the **Vision 2021 Transition Team** that will be presented to the messengers at *Summit, The Gathering of Tennessee Baptists* in Chattanooga will reflect a bold, new direction for our Convention. The focus will be on the mission of impacting lostness in Tennessee and around the world. We will have relationships strengthened around strategy, not tradition. And, by focusing on a few priorities, we will do our work with greater excellence.

With the great challenges facing all of us doing Kingdom work, we must lean on one another and our Lord like never before. I am extremely hopeful about the days ahead. ## Union University

We are a grateful community at Union University for the numerous ways that God has blessed the work of our hands during the 2012-13 academic year, including an enrollment increase for the sixteenth straight year. Annual non-duplicating enrollment exceeded 5,000 for the third year in a row.

Union was pleased to invest the generous cooperative program gifts from the churches across the Tennessee Baptist Convention in the lives of hundreds of students who attended Union University during this past year. Many of the dollars went directly to provide scholarship assistance for students whose parents serve on the mission field, in local churches, and with denominational agencies.

Union has responded to invitations from the IMB and NAMB to create a special masters program in Christian Studies for missionaries and bi-vocational pastors. We are honored to serve the Baptist family in this way with an emphasis on missional, Kingdom-focused higher education.

Union continued to be recognized for high quality academics by *U.S. News and World Report* and numerous other publications. The recognitions were more significant than ever.

Nearly 1,150 students graduated from Union University this past year. These students will serve in Tennessee, in this region, across the country, and around the globe.

Union provided extensive leadership for the efforts to advance Christ-centered higher education through the publication of the volume on *Faith and Learning* (Baptist & Holman) and the multi-volume series on “Reclaiming the Christian Intellectual Tradition” (Crossway). In many ways Union stands as a leader in the Baptist and evangelical worlds in helping to shape distinctive Christ-centered higher education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

Several hundred students were involved in dozens of global mission opportunities, local church and para-church ministries, and community service efforts.

We are thankful for our long-standing partnership with the Tennessee Baptist Convention. We pray for God’s ongoing blessings to rest on Union University as we seek to advance the cause of Christ-centered higher education in the Baptist tradition. We are grateful to the churches of the TBC and the friends of Union University across the state who provide prayer, encouragement, and financial support for our work, particularly for our students, staff, faculty and trustees.

## **Tennessee Baptist Children's Homes, Inc. 2013 Association Report**

The State of Tennessee is facing a significant challenge in providing an adequate number of Foster Parent Resource Homes for the constantly growing number of at risk children. The Tennessee Baptist Children's Homes has responded to this need by establishing a working relationship with DCS to recruit, train and engage Christian families to provide safe, strong homes for children in DCS custody.

An important part of the TBCH Foster Care Initiative is called the Caring Community Ministry (CCM). It is designed to be a lay-led ministry for support of foster families where they live and worship. It is important that families that open their homes have the necessary local support in order to be successful and help change the trajectory of the lives of at-risk children. Through the CCM that assistance can be provided to the Foster Care family.

TBCH is committed to providing the necessary support for the churches to ensure that the Caring Community Ministry concept will be a success for the children in care, the Foster Parents and church members who want to be a part of a mission endeavor without needing a passport or having to travel long distances. We hope that churches across Tennessee will see the CCM as an opportunity to reach out and minister in this critical way in their own communities.

During this year, your TBCH ministry has served approximately 200 children and their families through the residential care program. Additionally, 4 children have been led to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, and 8 students provided for as they pursue their college or post-secondary education.

The past few years have presented challenges as we have attempted to meet the needs of children in crisis. A decision was made many years ago that we would not accept government funds to underwrite this work. As we step out in faith to partner with DCS to care for more children we continue to trust God, working through His people, to meet our needs. We ask that you prayerfully consider your response to both the Mother's Day Offering and the Cooperative Program.

THANK YOU Tennessee Baptists for your prayers, your volunteer service, and your gifts. Together, we are making a difference for the Kingdom!

### **Tennessee Baptist Adult Homes**

In telling the story of the Good Samaritan, Jesus stressed that the Samaritan looked upon the needy man beside the road with compassion and then ministered and “took care of him”. The man was a stranger but a fellow human being. Your Tennessee Baptist Adult Homes ministry rarely has to deal with abused individuals, thankfully, but does welcome in the elderly, the frail, and the disabled who need someone to minister to them and take care of them. They may come to us as strangers, but it isn’t long until they are family and our residences they call “home”. They find compassion and care in the name of Christ and learn that Tennessee Baptists across the state are praying for them and contributing resources for their support. There is an entire network of Baptist believers who take Jesus’ words seriously about ministering to “the least of these” (Matt. 25:40).

Tennessee Baptist Adult Homes on any given day provides residences for 55 intellectually disabled persons in six group homes at four locations and another 300+ senior adults on three campuses. Your Cooperative Program and Father’s Day Offering gifts help make these residences possible. Additionally, for two weeks each summer a Special Friends Camp is held for intellectually disabled persons. This year there were about 270 campers served by some 70 staff. The camps are held at the TBC Carson Springs and Linden Valley Conference Centers and are underwritten to a large extent by the Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions.

Quality of life and quality of care are stressed in every area of the ministry. The staff serves with the realization that every person is created in the image of God and one for whom Christ gave his life. Each resident and camper is treated with respect and every effort possible is made to insure that they enjoy a full life rather than endure a painful and lonely existence. Activities and opportunities for worship and fellowship are essential to the well-being of those we have the blessing of serving. 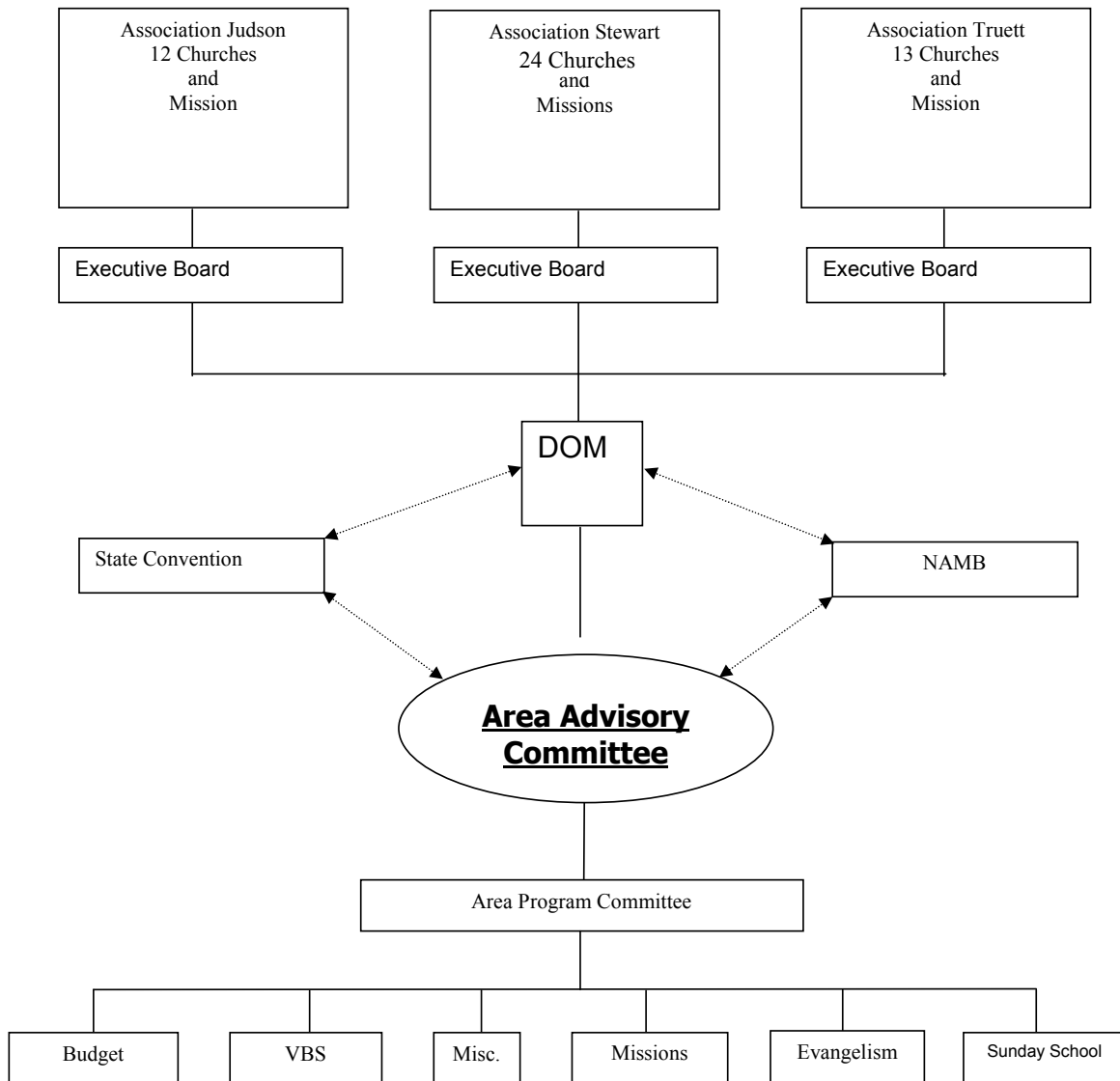
