

Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association

The Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association shall be **THE BAPTIST FAITH AND MESSAGE** as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention, May 9, 1963.

Constitution Of the Stewart County Baptist Association

- 1. This Association shall be composed of Messengers from only Missionary Baptist Churches which, are affiliated with the Southern Baptist Convention and shall be called the Stewart County Baptist Association.
- 2. Each Church shall be entitled to six messengers, and six alternates, plus the pastor. An alternate may be substituted in the event of a duly elected messenger being unable to attend. The Messengers and alternates must be elected by the church and recorded on the annual associational letter. There shall not be any proxy (substitute) messengers.
- 3. The object of the Association shall not be to exercise ecclesiastical authority over the churches, but to promote love and spiritual unity and advance the cause of Missions.
- 4. The Association shall elect annually a Moderator (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years), Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer, whose duties shall be those usual for their office. Their term of office shall begin at the close of the last session of the Annual Associational Meeting. The above named officers shall be our standing Associational Program Committee. The Moderator and Missionary shall be ex-officio members of all committees of the Association.
- 5. The Moderator shall appoint a nominating committee of seven people which, said Committee shall nominate all committees and chairman of standing committees or any other position not provided for by the annual meeting as needed. The committee shall present their report to Annual Association on the first day of the Association's action. The nominating committee shall maintain a rotating system of committee structure.
- 6. Corresponding messengers and others, not members of the Association may be entitled to seats with the privileges of speaking but not voting.
- 7. The Clerk shall send to each Church a number of Minutes in proportion to its contribution to the printing fund.
- 8. A majority of the messengers in attendance shall constitute a quorum.
- 9. This Association, by two-thirds vote, may refuse to receive the messengers of a church considered irregular in faith and practice.
- 10. This Association shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order in all points not provided by this constitution.
- 11. No amendment shall be made to this constitution except by two-thirds vote.
- 12. This association shall provide an **EXECUTIVE BOARD** which, shall transact business matters; promote and direct the work of the Association between the sessions of the association. The Executive Board shall meet regularly, once each quarter, with provision being made for special called meetings. A one week notification by mail or phone shall be required for all special called meetings of the Executive Board. The Executive Board shall be composed of all pastors of the churches and one member who is elected by each church, plus all department heads of the Association and the Clerk and Treasurer of the Association. The Clerk, Treasurer and Parliamentarian of the Association also will serve on the Executive Board. Fifteen members shall constitute a Quorum. This Board shall elect its Chairman (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years) and Vice Chairman annually.

STEWART COUNTY ASSOCIATION ANNUAL MEETING

Thursday, October 21, 2004

The meeting was held at Bear Springs Baptist Church.

Time: 5:00 pm

The evening started with a ham and chicken dinner provided by the ladies of Bear Springs Baptist Church. Bro. Wray Forrest asked the Lord to bless the meal. There was an abundance of food and fellowship.

Bro. Bill Ramsey, Pastor of Bear Springs, welcomed the Association to their church and stated they were glad to be able to host the 101st Annual Meeting in their new church. Bro. Bill expressed appreciation to the members of Bear Springs in the preparation of the food and helping with their new church.

Moderator Wray Forrest opened the meeting with prayer, asking that each person present receive a blessing from Bro. Mike Vidal's upcoming message. He requested all attendees to conduct the meeting in a harmonious and Christian manner. Moderator Forrest then asked Dr. James Porch, T.B.C. to present his report.

Dr. Porch addressed the group telling of the 2200 churches that have 100 or less persons attending. The T.B. Association is composed of small churches, most are Bi-Vocational, where the Pastor works a job in additional to his church duties. The TBC these days are helping build healthy and spiritual churches. The greatest thing in a church is to Celebrate It's Uniqueness and the value of each individual church.

Dr. Porch next spoke about the works of the Cooperative Program. The Program began in Memphis in 1925, so for 79 years they have supplied mission support. Dr. Porch spoke about the fact God does not re-do anything. He creates everything new. This is what needs to happen to the Cooperative Program, we need to re-"new" our commitments to support its great efforts.

Sister June Simmons, Director of the Good Samaritan's Program, gave the Good Samaritan Report. She explained how the Good Samaritan sells items, but is also strongly involved in providing emergency assistance funds to the community. In the time frame of April- September, the Good Samaritan provided \$ 8,800 in emergency funds to 269 families or individuals locally. Sister Simmons thanked all the churches for the funding they provide, but asked if each could up the anti just a little bit more, it would benefit more. Sister Simmons stated the Good Samaritan also helps children in Afghanistan.

Bro. Richard Williams came to speak about the Angel Food Ministries. He stated it is a growing program, which assists persons in buying food. Each box costs \$25.00, but has a value of 50 - 75 in contents. Each distribution center must sell a minimum of 75 boxes to get the orders delivered. The next deadline will be the 6^{th} of November. The holidays

in November and December are creating earlier deadlines. Pray more will become involved and more boxes will sell so semi truck can deliver to Dover. If interested in purchasing a box contact Bro. Williams or anyone at First Baptist Church.

Department Head Reports are printed in the program. Bro. Gray read the Prayer Coordinator's report, as Sister Molly Taylor was unable to attend.

Bro. Russell Luffman led the group in singing all verses of *Amazing Grace*. Tommy and Carolyn Beechum, singing *The Next Time You See Me*, then provided special music.

Bro. Mike Vidal then brought the Doctrinal message. Bro. Mike proceeded to read from John 14:1-6. Tonight's message will be about Heaven. He stated that people are faced with a death threat daily and do not know how to respond. People cannot face death. Non-Christians see death as *No Hope*, while Christians see death as *Hope*. Jesus gave us the greatest assurance of heaven, three things we need to know about John 3:16;

- Heaven is real.
 Only understanding what Heaven will not be like; will give us the true understanding of heaven.

- 3. Heaven is restricted.

 Heaven is a restricted and exclusive neighborhood. Only those who have put their faith in Jesus Christ will be allowed to enter and live there.
