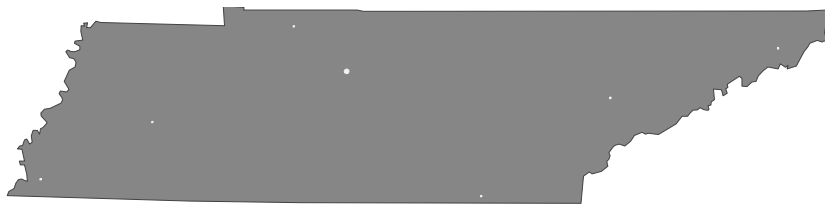

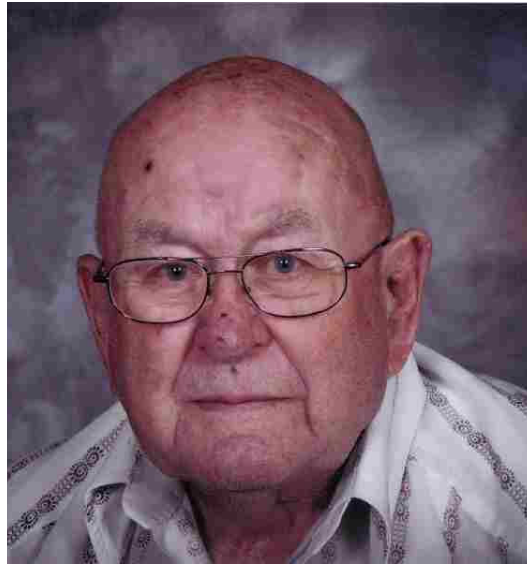

# Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association

The Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association shall be **THE BAPTIST FAITH AND MESSAGE** as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention, May 9, 1963.

## Constitution Of the Stewart County Baptist Association

1. This Association shall be composed of Messengers from only Missionary Baptist Churches which, are affiliated with the Southern Baptist Convention and shall be called the Stewart County Baptist Association.
2. Each Church shall be entitled to six messengers, and six alternates, plus the pastor. An alternate may be substituted in the event of a duly elected messenger being unable to attend. **THE MESSENGERS AND ALTERNATES MUST BE ELECTED BY THE CHURCH AND RECORDED ON THE ANNUAL ASSOCIATIONAL LETTER. THERE SHALL NOT BE ANY PROXY (SUBSTITUTE) MESSENGERS.**
3. The object of the Association shall not be to exercise ecclesiastical authority over the churches, but to promote love and spiritual unity and advance the cause of Missions.
4. The Association shall elect annually a Moderator (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years), Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer, whose duties shall be those usual for their office. Their term of office shall begin at the close of the last session of the Annual Associational Meeting. The above named officers shall be our standing Associational Program Committee. The Moderator and Missionary shall be ex-officio members of all committees of the Association.
5. The Moderator shall appoint a nominating committee of seven people which, said Committee shall nominate all committees and chairman of standing committees or any other position not provided for by the annual meeting as needed. The committee shall present their report to Annual Association on the first day of the Association's action. The nominating committee shall maintain a rotating system of committee structure.
6. Corresponding messengers and others, not members of the Association may be entitled to seats with the privileges of speaking but not voting.
7. The Clerk shall send to each Church a number of Minutes in proportion to its contribution to the printing fund.
8. A majority of the messengers in attendance shall constitute a quorum.
9. This Association, by two-thirds vote, may refuse to receive the messengers of a church considered irregular in faith and practice.
10. This Association shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order in all points not provided by this constitution.
11. No amendment shall be made to this constitution except by two-thirds vote.
12. This association shall provide an **EXECUTIVE BOARD** which, shall transact business matters; promote and direct the work of the Association between the sessions of the association. The Executive Board shall meet regularly, once each quarter, with provision being made for special called meetings. A one week notification by mail or phone shall be required for all special called meetings of the Executive Board. The Executive Board shall be composed of all pastors of the churches and one member who is elected by each church, plus all department heads of the Association and the Clerk and Treasurer of the Association. The Clerk, Treasurer and Parliamentarian of the Association also will serve on the Executive Board. Fifteen members shall constitute a Quorum. This Board shall elect its Chairman (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years) and Vice Chairman annually.

**106th Annual Session**

**Mount Sinai Baptist Church**  
October 15, 2009

Our 106<sup>th</sup> Session was called to order by Moderator David Whitehead, who then requested the Clerk to come and seat the Messengers. With the seating of Messengers, Moderator Whitehead then asked for a motion to Adopt the program. Motion was made by Bro. James Wyatt, the second from Bro. Roland Mudge. Moderator Whitehead asked for New Pastors or Staff. Bro. Dennis Jones, Pastor of Yellow Creek, introduced himself; this was his first Annual Associational Meeting. Moderator Whitehead requested the Clerk to come and present the Digest of Letters. The Clerk presented the information gathered from the churches and asked for any changes or additions. There were none. Moderator Whitehead requested the treasurer to present the Treasurer's Report. The balance on hand was \$18, 609.39 with a balance on hand in the Crusade fund at \$ 486.35. A motion from the floor to accept the report as given was made, seconded and carried. Moderator Whitehead then asked for a report from the Budget Committee. The proposed budget for the 2009-2010 year has small increases, approximately \$320 more than the 2008-2009 budgets. A motion made by Bro. Roland Mudge and seconded by Bro. James Link, was carried. Moderator Whitehead then expressed his appreciation to the Association and to Bro. James Wyatt for allowing him to serve the last two years as Moderator, to Bro. Wyatt for filling in during his absence. At this time the business section of the session was entered into.

**Moderator** - DOM William Gray presided over the nominations for Moderator. Nominations from the floor were Bro. James Wyatt, nominations ceased and motion made to elect Bro Wyatt as Moderator, this was seconded and carried. Vice Moderator – Bro. Joe Shannon was nominated to serve as Vice Moderator. Clerk – Moderator Whitehead asked for any nominations from the floor. Natalie Hardison was submitted as clerk. Nominations ceased and motion from floor was made to elect Ms Hardison, seconded and carried. Treasurer – Lynda Hicklen will continue. Moderator Whitehead then asked these nominations be accepted by acclamation, motion made, seconded and carried.

There are still the following positions to fill: Music Director, Sunday School Director and Volunteer Mission Director.

Miscellaneous Business – Bro. Gray presented the option of dedicating the Minute Books in Memory of Bro. Clarence Shemwell, Deacon at Maranatha and Bro. Don Morrow, Deacon at First Baptist, Dover. It was recommended that the Minute Book for the coming year 2009-2010, be dedicated to Bro. George and Sister Wyatt. Recommendations were made motions, seconded and carried.

Moderator Whitehead asked Bro. Wray Forrest to come and present the Time, Place and Preacher Report for the 107<sup>th</sup> Annual Session. The Session will be held at New Faith Baptist Church on October 14, 2010. Supper will begin at 5:00 p.m with Session to follow at 5:45 p.m. The Doctrinal Sermon will be presented by Bro. Lance Parker, Pastor of New Faith Baptist Church; alternate will be Bro. George Hall, Pastor of Carlisle Baptist Church. The Evangelistic Sermon will be given by Bro. Dale Taylor, Pastor of Bear Spring Baptist Church; alternate will be Bro Robert Reason, Pastor of Calvary Baptist.

Moderator Whitehead requested a motion be made to accept this report as given, motion made, seconded and carried.

The Obituary Report was given by Sister Nancy Mullins, who read from Romans 6:5-11. A moment of silence was held for all the Brothers and Sisters who have gone to meet the Master.

Special Music was presented by Mt Sinai, singing "HE Died for me".

Bro. Gray then introduced Bro. Mitchell Allen, Pastor of Pugh Flat Baptist Church who presented the Doctrinal Message. Bro. Allen read from Eph 3:20-21, stating that we are kept by the Power of God, no man can pluck me from my Father's Hand. We as Baptist go back to the days of Christ; Pastors should lead by example and love the Church.

Moderator Whitehead asked for other Reports or Committee Reports. There were none. The offering taken up for Mt Sinai Baptist Church came to \$980.00; this will assist the church in building their sanctuary. Moderator Whitehead thanked all for working with him.

Bro. James Wyatt closed the 106<sup>th</sup> Session in prayer.

## **DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING REPORT**

The Association Discipleship Training Program serves the churches through its effort to satisfy at least four needs:

1. More meaningful Christian fellowship.
2. Increased spiritual motivation.
3. Better understanding of Discipleship Training.
4. Greater involvement in shared experiences.

The Association has an opportunity to help churches accomplish these training tasks: training new church members, training church leaders, and training church members. Training is still done in the majority of our churches on Sunday nights as on-going training in small groups by ages using pre-graded materials, but it is being expanded more and more to other approaches using Equipping Centers, New Member Training, Masterlife and Disciple Youth, Individual Training, Study Course Books and Baptist Doctrine Study. We assist churches in all areas of training and believe our task is to see all church members following Christ in discipleship. All church members disciplined to their full potential is exactly what Jesus told us to do in Mt. 28:19-20, “As you go make disciples....and teach them to do (observe).”

**To accomplish this goal we will work towards the following objectives in the coming year:**

1. Lead our churches to provide new member training.
2. Encourage members from each church to attend “M” Night. (A Goal of 100 in attendance).
3. Encourage members from each church to participate in our Associational D.T. Program.
4. Promote participation in the Church Study Course, and Life Programs.
5. To strive for 100% of churches in the association with a Discipleship Training program.

**MID-CONTINENT UNIVERSITY**  
**ANNUAL REPORT TO THE BAPTIST ASSOCIATIONS**  
**2008-2009**

This has been a banner year for your University. The Lord blessed us with nearly 2,000 students, our largest enrollment ever and the University once again completed our fiscal year in the black. God is richly blessing MCU as we continue to reach students for Christ—on campus, off, campus, and online. The following briefs were prepared by our various divisions and departments.

**The Baptist College of the Bible Update**

By the numbers Mid-Continent University is keeping faith with our mission. Seventeen students graduated with ministry degrees during the 2008-2009 academic year.

The College of the Bible also provided twelve college credit hours for the forty-one graduates of the traditional programs, six college credit hours were for those graduates who received an Associates Degree, and fifteen college credit hours for those receiving the bachelors in Business Management degree in the Advantage program. There were a total of eighty-one Christian Studies classes taught in the Advantage program.

The College of the Bible programs have been enhanced to allow students to earn a double major without having to take extra credit hours.

Our adult Christian ministry program, taught in the Advantage format, began in 2007 with twenty-one students enrolled. A second cohort began in November, 2008 with twenty-one students. A third cohort is scheduled to begin in October, 2009. The College of the Bible taught the classes in the adult Christian Ministry program during the 2007-2008 academic year. These students are working toward a Bachelor of Ministry or a Bachelor of Science in Christian Ministries.

The College of the Bible is working to fund the Bible College Scholarship Fund. Contributions made by individuals, churches, and associations designated to this scholarship fund are being accepted and will assure continued support of our ministerial students. In April, 2009 three scholarships were awarded from this fund.

Dr. Larry Orange has been named Dean of the Baptist College of the Bible. Dr. Orange was also recently elected President of the Educators for Bi-vocational Ministry, which is a part of the National Bi-vocational organization. The goal is to expand the presence of bi-vocational awareness on university campuses. In March 2009 the Mid-Continent Regional Bi-vocational Ministry Celebration was held at the Heartland Worship Center in Paducah.

The College of the Bible meets regularly for prayer and welcomes anyone to join in. The College also has two representatives speaking to churches, schools, and associations to build relationships with the College and University.

A College of the Bible Advisory Council has been formed. There are ten members currently serving, and there will be an additional ten selected to serve in the fall of 2009 to work with the faculty and staff and to promote the influence and development of the College of the Bible in the community. Currently there have been two meetings with the Council, the first in March and the second in July 2009.

A new application process is being developed for admission into the College of the Bible programs.

The Ministerial Association was activated in January, 2009.

Many of the College of the Bible faculty and staff assisted in disaster relief during the February, 2009 ice storm.

The College of the Bible hosted the College of the Bible Awards Banquet in March, 2009. Ten Honorary Doctorate degrees and five Distinguished Service Awards were given.

The opportunities for a domestic and international ministry of the University through the Global Mission Center continue to expand. Each field request received becomes a Macedonian Call to “come over and help us.” We are amazed at the positive response of these opportunities for ministry by our students, faculty, staff, and friends of the University.

The Global Mission Center currently has two major focus missions—Antigua and southern Arizona. In the spring of 2009 a task force was organized to oversee the mission projects of the University. At the same time a need for someone to provide a continuing personal presence Antigua was felt. By the time the Task Force had its initial meeting a volunteer couple with the exact skills needed for this task was enlisted. They have made a commitment to move to Antigua no later than October 1, 2009. Charles and Linda Erickson need prayer and financial support as they prepare to provide our University with a continuing presence in Antigua.

The primary project of building at least nine community centers in Antigua continues to be the long range goal of this ministry. Immediate projects related to this long range goal include:

- Providing maintenance support at Camp Blizzard in order that volunteer teams will have comfortable lodging and adequate meals.

- Acquiring property for and building an operation center.

- Expanding the medical/dental ministry started in 2008 by providing adequate facilities for the teams to perform their work.

Global Mission Center personnel are working with the Central Baptist Academy of Antigua as that institution seeks to add a program of post secondary education to their existing K-12 programs. Three students are currently enrolled in the University. Two in the Baptist College of the Bible, preparing for church related ministries and one in Baptist College of Arts and Science seeking a degree in Business Administration.

Drs. Imhoff and Cecil have traveled to Antigua again this year to organize the mission effort there. Thurman Penick, who will be directing the work of the mission teams, has also made the trip.

The second focus of the Global Mission Center is mission work being done on Native American reservations in southern Arizona. Two teams have gone to teach Bible school and repair church buildings in 2009, with another trip scheduled the week of Thanksgiving 2009.

Working with the Student Department of the International Mission Board, the Global Mission Center will seek to coordinate a fall 2009 Chapel Program that will inform our traditional students of the many mission opportunities available during the summer of 2010.

The Director of the Global Mission Center has been commissioned by the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention to assist in Native American Church Planting efforts. In addition to designing programs to initiate village Bible Study programs and directing leadership training programs among Native Americans, the Director is working with Golden Gate Theological Seminary in designing mentoring programs for Native American Students enrolled in their Scottsdale, Arizona Campus.

A Center for Biblical Creation has been established by the College of the Bible. Faris Sahawneh has been named the Director. The Center has been developed as a result of the Defenders of the Faith Conference which was held at the University in June, 2008. The Center will be working with Answers in Genesis organization to develop a traveling program to teach middle school and high school students how to defend their faith based on biblical creation.

### **The Baptist College of Arts & Science**

We will soon re-submit our application to our accrediting agency for a Master's Degree in Human Resource Management.

The petition to SACS/COC to offer the Psychology degree online remains active. Human Resources and Human Resources

With University support some Mid-Continent faculty members have gone back to graduate school to reinforce their credentials.

A new year of applications have started.

We recently were approved by the State of Kentucky to license the Associate Degree programs online.

We have accepted the recent resignations of Mr. Richard Throgmorton (retirement) and Dr. Ken Norton (he accepted another position closer to his home in North Carolina). Both may still do some adjunct teaching for us.

We are negotiating with particular individuals to hire in the areas of Finance, Management, Music, and Psychology.

For the third year in a row, we met our goal of collecting/acquiring 1,000 hard copy books for our library. Our total access to on-line book volumes are over a billion books. We have also increased our number of hard copy journals from twenty-one to forty.

### **The Division of Finance & Administration**

In 2008-2009, we completed implementation of a new performance review process for non-supervisory personnel and established a new and improved background check process for all new employees; installed Smart Boards in several classrooms which will provide an enhanced and interactive teaching platform; completed construction on an eighteen hundred square foot student recreation area and added an additional thirty-six hundred square foot of space that includes equipment storage, fleet maintenance center, and increased work area for the Facilities Department; and upgraded an existing eight hundred square foot facility that houses the International Program and the Global Language School.

In 2009-2010, we will convert personnel files from paper to magnetic media; complete installation of Smart Boards in all classrooms; deploy Microsoft SharePoint and InfoPath applications campus wide, which will enhance the availability of data access both locally and remotely and reduce the amount of paper documents produced and handled; deploy a Citrix Server which will enable employees to have access from off-campus to their campus computer workstation; develop existing space to house the Student and Career Services offices to allow for growth and to better accommodate the students; and develop off-campus property to prepare for future construction of an Adult Services facility.

### **The Advantage Adult Program**

Since Advantage began, we have started two hundred thirty-three groups and graduated one hundred fifty-six groups. This past spring Advantage enrollment was at one thousand six hundred forty-nine. This past fiscal year we have added the new location of London, Kentucky. In addition, we expect to add Fulton and Somerset, Kentucky this summer and Covington, Kentucky this fall. This summer our fulltime online student enrollment will double, from seventy-five to one hundred fifty. Last fiscal year applications totaled one thousand fifty-one, and despite a tough economy, the Advantage Program grew 14%.

### **The External Relations Office**

Jim Gibson, former Christian music publishing executive, has been named Vice-President for External Relations. In his new role, in addition to the development of financial support to the University, he will give leadership and oversight to general public and media relations, external publications, marketing, church relations, alumni support and to denominational relations.

## **Tennessee Missions and Ministry**

Once again consistent to heritage, the State Missions staff joined Tennessee Baptists in pursuing a mission passion throughout the year. Hundreds of churches led of the Holy Spirit responded to the Baptist axiom of local church autonomy, and literally went unto the utter most parts of God's world.

A mission dream became focused with the donation of 20 acres of land near Mt. Juliet Tennessee by the Don Davis family. The site, a future mission mobilization center gained new thrust through the launch of a capital fund-raising campaign.

Missions focus - long range- received affirmation through the Annual Convention gathering adoption of the five-year partnership agreement with West Africa. While we officially completed our gospel sharing season in Rio de Janeiro many churches continue ministry to the Brazilian city.

By maintaining constant monitoring of Cooperative Program gifts, the Executive Board One Servant Family took advanced steps to continue to provide effective ministry within limited resources. Simultaneously efforts were initiated to assist churches shepherding folk through challenging economic times, and always with the appreciation of the sacrificial giving of the Tennessee Baptist family.

Primarily due to the nation's economical recession the work of the Executive Board's Property Transition Committee continued at a slower pace.

Early in 2008, Executive Director-Treasurer James M. Porch, announced his transition toward a new ministry passion beginning in 2010, and the Administrative Committee initiated the process to select the next Executive Director-Treasurer.

*A personal word from me to you* .....The intended destination in opening my Bible to Joshua focused on the insight, "You have not passed this way before" (Deuteronomy 3:4). I read on, allowing the next verse to capture my attention—"For tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you" (Deuteronomy 3:5).

At the exact right time, in the appropriate place, and aware of the mood of the tribes, God gave Joshua the message apparently the Hebrew people most needed to hear. Within our expectation of tomorrow abides the possibility of God's great, not yet but coming, blessings.

Originally leaning toward "You have not passed this way before," I had limited my perspective to dwell on *now*. True, ignoring the present creates danger. Nevertheless, our Heavenly Father seeks to acquaint, if not confront, His people with a balance—the wonder of tomorrow.

Earlier Israel heard the pronouncement, "You have stayed long enough at this mountain. Turn and set your journey..." (Deuteronomy 1:67) for God had placed the land before them.

Each Tennessee Baptist association of local churches has a land before their corporate and individual ministry, a local land and a land even beyond any believer's expectation.

Within this context, I hear the challenge of the Father—nurture your wonder for my tomorrows for you in the lands before you.
